Act quickly: you can offer a distraction, ask for help from another person, or intervene directly if you feel able to.

Respect your limits and do not put yourself in danger.

Be in solidarity with the victim: listen to them, and allow them to go to a space where they feel safe. And above all, **believe what they tell you.**

Report the situation to volunteers or security. In case of an emergency, dial 911.
